PRIMARY DUTIES

Duties may include, but are limited to, the following:

1. Plan, prioritize, assign, supervise and review the work staff involved in water and wastewater treatment operations, maintenance and repair work.
2. Evaluate operations and activities; recommend improvements and modifications; prepare various reports on operation and activities.
3. Prepare cost estimates for budget recommendations; submit justifications for budget requests; assist in controlling expenditures.
4. Participate in the selection of staff; provide or coordinate staff training; work with employees to correct deficiencies.
5. Answer questions and provide information to the public; investigate complaints and recommend corrective action as necessary to resolve complaints.
6. Participate in the full range of water and wastewater treatment operations, maintenance, and repair duties including performing the most difficult duties assigned to the work unit.
7. Check water and wastewater facilities and equipment for needed maintenance and repairs. Inspect the work of staff while in progress; provide advice and assistance.
8. Maintain time, material and equipment use records; requisition supplies and materials. Prepare state wastewater discharge reports and other monitoring requirements set forth by the permit approval. Perform related duties as assigned.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Meets the physical requirements necessary to safely and effectively perform required duties. Knowledge of modern water and wastewater treatment principles, practices, methods and procedures.

1. Knowledge of materials and equipment used in a full range of water and wastewater treatment operations, maintenance and repair activities.
2. Knowledge of methods and precautions in storing and handling a variety of chemicals.
3. Knowledge of elements of construction technology as they relate to water and wastewater treatment plant facilities and equipment construction, maintenance and repair activities.
4. Knowledge of methods and precautions in storing and handling a variety of chemicals.
5. Knowledge of functions and purposes of water / wastewater treatment systems. Principles of personnel supervision, training and evaluation. Safe work practices.

6. Ability to operate and maintain a variety of water and wastewater treatment plant equipment. Perform and interpret standardized process control tests and adjust plant equipment and process appropriately.
7. Maintain records and prepare routine reports. Supervise, train and evaluate assigned staff.
8. Establish and maintain cooperative working relationships with those contacted in the course of work. Communicate clearly and concisely, both orally and in writing.
9. Proven leadership abilities.

WORKING CONDITIONS

Work in wastewater collection system, water distribution , water treatment and wastewater treatment plant environments; some exposure to water, chemicals, hazardous materials, and noise; heavy lifting/moving, standing, climbing. May work at heights, in confined spaces, and in inclement weather conditions.
